LS Lowry Workshops

During these workshops your class will work with a professional artist to explore the work of LS Lowry. During the workshop the artist will take the children into the Galleries to see the artworks and then create a response to what they have seen.

Our LS Lowry workshops are themed around his Industrial Scenes, Landscapes and Portraits; exploring perspective, proportions and creative responses.

All LS Lowry workshops can be explored through dance, drama or visual art.


From the grotesque to the wonderful, these digital artists examine how technology has transformed our understanding of the human body and mind.
