The Lowry's Learning and Engagement team receive appropriate training, which includes safe-guarding and counter-terrorism. The Learning and Engagement office is situated close to the class-rooms, and in the event of any emergency, a member of staff would be there to assist you. There are three fire exits close to the classrooms and emergency lights indicating exit routes.

In addition to The Lowry's pre-existing, robust procedures, we have increased security officer presence in all front of house areas and have introduced random bag searches, as well as a number of measures taken organisationally behind the scenes.

	Control Measures
	Risk: Trips/Slips:
1	 Building well lit, kept clear of obstruction, cleaning and maintenance on hand, Health & Safety signage identifies spillages/temporary hazards. Information on building sent to schools prior to visit. Workshop leaders remind students of safe ways of travelling through the building and advise no running. Students supervised by school staff and workshop leader at all times. Classrooms checked for cleanliness and health & safety pre and post activity on a daily basis. First Aid available if necessary.
	Risk: Mechanical Hazards:
2	 Workshop leaders advise students on safe ways of using all materials/equipment. All equipment suitable for classroom use and supervised by workshop leaders. Workshop leader gives safety advice on using escalator/stairs. Gallery staff monitor school parties using escalators. Students supervised by school staff at all times. School staff to be placed at the top and bottom of escalator whilst in use by pupils. Safety treads and handrails on escalators and stairs. First Aid available if necessary.
	Risk: Lost/abducted children:
3	 School staff to ensure all children accounted for on entering/exiting building. School staff to remain with class at all times. Workshop leader remains with class at all times during activity. Workshop leaders remind class of safety procedures and expectations of behaviour. Pupils reminded to approach member of Front of House or Gallery staff if separated from their party. Emergency Procedure in place with Lowry Security.
	Risk: Hazardous Substances:
4	 All artistic materials COSHH rated and suitable for classroom use. Activity supervised by workshop leaders. Students supervised by school staff at all times. First Aid available if necessary. Access to water available in classrooms.

	Risk: Temperature Hazards – too hot/cold:
5	 Students supervised by school staff at all times. Portable heater/fan available if required. Water cooler in Studio foyer. Air conditioning available. First Aid available if necessary.

Ventilation systems will provide 100% fresh air and not recirculate air from one space to another. Switch heating ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) systems to drawing in fresh air where they can be, rather than recirculating air.
8.5	 Risk: Contracting or spreading the virus in indoor spaces during Lunch Maintaining social distancing between schools. Masks are optional for children, school staff encouraged to wear them.
