## The Village

The Lowry no longer operates a backstage canteen.

The Village is a backstage Green Room where visiting Company Members may meet and eat their own food. There are two vending machines which serve free hot drinks, fridges, microwaves and a Toaster.

As The Village is a shared area, we ask all Visiting Company Members to treat the space with respect and to clear up after themselves. There are bins and cleaning materials provided for this purpose.

## Parking and Transport

Please note there is NO parking available at the Lowry.

Pre-paid car parking vouchers for The Quayside Mediacity Mall (postcode M50 3AH) are £6.50 per day and allow up to 24 hours of pre-validated car parking. These can be purchased by visiting the Box Office or from the Car Park itself (The Outlet Mall is about 200 yds from The Lowry and is a completely separate business with no links to The Lowry.)

There are a limited number of car recharging points available within the Car Park

The Lowry houses the largest public collection of paintings and drawings by LS Lowry in the world. Featuring some of his most famous and important works this exhibition shows an artist remarkable for his diversity and fearless innovation.

Claire Stewart, curator of The Lowry Collection at The Lowry, said: “We’re proud to house the world’s largest public collection of Lowry work – and in extending the exhibition in this way we further strengthening that position as the home of LS Lowry.

“Some of the new works on display haven’t been seen in public for many years and we are grateful to the owners for the opportunity to present them to our gallery visitors. This new exhibition will also look at Lowry’s contemporaries and highlight what life was like in Salford in the early 1900s.”

There are over 400 works in the collection, 57 of which are oil paintings. Alongside the works of art is an archive containing thousands of items ranging from photographs to press cuttings and exhibition catalogues. Both the collection and archive were formed by Salford Museum & Art Gallery and transferred to The Lowry in 2000. A selection of highlights from the Collection can always be seen on display in our permanent **LS Lowry - The Art & The Artist** exhibition alongside works on loan from important private collections throughout the UK.
