

Trafford Road Improvement Scheme Resurfacing Works

Phase 1 – From Trafford Road bridge to The Quays

Please note this document has been updated on 4 April with revised closure times during the first two weeks of the works. Please refer to <u>p.8 for details.</u>

From 9 April we will begin the resurfacing works along Trafford Road from the Trafford Road bridge to the junction with The Quays. This is Phase 1.

This work will take place in April and May and during the summer. Most of this work will take place overnight, to minimise potential disruption to traffic.

Between 9 April and 23 April night works will start at 19:30 and then at 19:00 between 25 April and 12 May, although you will see men working to put traffic management out 30 minutes before the closure is in place. The work will be completed in stages so there will be no continuous road closure other than the shift hours detailed further in the document.

Certain measures have been implemented to mitigate noise levels:

- Milling (explained under Phase 1 Overview) work to be minimised at 00:30, where possible.
- Areas near to residents will be undertaken at weekends (days), where possible.
- Breaking out most of the iron work (manhole covers, road gullies and duct covers) will be undertaken during the day to reduce noise at night and without closing the road.

This has been discussed with Salford City Council, TfGM and the following programme agreed by all parties.

These works will be completed in three stages. The details of when the work will be taking place and at what locations are included below. The final high friction surface coating will take place 28 days after Stage 2 is completed. We will update you with days and times prior to this work taking place.

Please note the provided schedule is subject to change if the works are stalled for reasons outside of our control such as adverse weather. We will provide updates should any delays occur.

Phase 2 - from The Quays to the roundabout at the M602 roundabout – To be confirmed

This work will take place in the summer and we will contact you with dates as soon as these are planned in.















Frequently Asked Questions

What is Controlled Access?

This means there will be traffic lights controlled by a member of staff at the specified location. They may not be able to let you through straightaway as work is taking place within the area you need to pass. Rather than closing the road completely we can enable access but there will be a waiting period.

Closures Southbound are from the M602 Roundabout no matter where you are working, why is this?

It is closed from the roundabout to stop any unnecessary traffic issues at the working area. Closures are mainly in place for 'through traffic' which is using Trafford Road as a route to White City Roundabout and beyond. To avoid the closure the diversion via Regent Road needs to be used.

If vehicles were to get to The Quays and then use Broadway, this would cause volumes of traffic and potentially cause traffic jams through this area, therefore we divert traffic prior to getting to the working area.

What do the different colour lines represent on the map drawings?

The coloured lines indicate the following:

RED LINE – road closure section

BLUE LINE – diversion route

GREEN LINE – alternative diversion route


Phase 1 Overview – Stage 1: Milling and Binder Course

The first stage of works will take place over eight sections to complete milling works and laying the binder course. Milling is the process of removing the top layer of asphalt without disturbing the underlying subbase. The binder course is the first layer of asphalt to be laid.

Machines will be used to do this work and it will be noisy so to minimise this disruption all milling operations will be reduced at 00:30 between 9 April - 23 April and then at 00:00 between 25 April - 12 May. Work in residential areas will be undertaken during the day at weekends, where we are able to.

The work will move up in sections across eight areas and will work up Trafford Road from the Trafford Road bridge to The Quays and back down. Please see the drawing below to view the different areas and the table for dates and times of working.

In the sections around Metrolink milling work will be undertaken after 01:15 to avoid service disruption.








Phase 1 Overview – Stage 2: Surface Course

This work is provisionally scheduled to take place throughout June and July. We will update you with detailed days and times prior to this taking place.



















Area 4: Merchants Quay to The Trafford Road bridge, Southbound











