



## Trafford Road Improvement Scheme: Resurfacing Work: 23 August – 22 October

From 23 August we will begin the resurfacing work along Trafford Road **from The Quays to the M602 Roundabout**. This work will be carried out in sections, which are detailed below.

The work will take place **between August and October** and most of the work needs to take place overnight. This is because we need to fully close roads to do this work which we are unable to do through the day.

Night work will start at 7pm, although you will see people working to put traffic management out from 6.30pm. The work will be completed in stages so there will be no continuous road closure other than the shift hours detailed further in the document.

We will take measures to minimise noise levels by:

- Minimising very noisy work by 12.30am, wherever possible
- Breaking out most of the iron work (manhole covers, road gullies and duct covers) during the day to reduce noise at night and without closing the road

These plans have been discussed and agreed with Salford City Council and Transport for Greater Manchester (TfGM).

### How will the work be done?

The work will be completed in three stages. The details of when the work will take place and at what locations are included below. The final, high friction surface coating will take place 28 days after stage two is completed.



Please note, the schedule is subject to change if there are delays because of issues such as adverse weather conditions. We will provide updates wherever possible.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Some closures are from the M602 Roundabout to the White City roundabout no matter where you're working, why is this?**

It's closed the full length of the road to stop any unnecessary traffic issues at the working areas. Closures are mainly in place for through traffic using Trafford Road as a route to White City Roundabout and beyond. To avoid the closure, please use the diversion via Regent Road.

We also need to ensure that there's enough access for our plant and machinery to move efficiently around the site. These larger closures will ensure we make the best use of the time allocated to get large areas of work complete.

### **Why does the work have to be done overnight?**

Trafford Road is a major route in Salford used by hundreds of vehicles each day. Closing this busy route through the day would cause major delays throughout Salford and Manchester. We don't take the decision to work overnight lightly but this work cannot be carried out safely unless full road closures are in place.

## Trafford Road resurfacing schedule

### What's happening?

We need to resurface the roads we've been working on to provide a smooth and safe new surface. This will be taking place on Trafford Road between The Quays and the M602 Roundabout.

We will also apply a new, high friction road surface and paint white lines, and other road markings.

### What's involved?

To resurface the road we need to prepare it by removing some of the existing surface before applying the new one. This is the noisiest bit of the work which will be completed in the first few weeks of the works, by 8 September. We also need to reset gutter covers and manhole lids as well as repaint white lines and other road markings. The works will be less disruptive.

### When will it take place?

To do this work, we need to fully close the roads at night. The closures will be in place on different sections of Trafford Road on weeknights only as follows:

- **23 August – 22 October**  
Closures between 7pm – 6:30am
- **4 - 7 October**  
Closures between 7:30pm – 6:30am

Please note we'll do our best to complete all the very noisy work by 12.30am in each shift.

Please note emergency access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly sign-posted. Diversion details can be found further in the document.

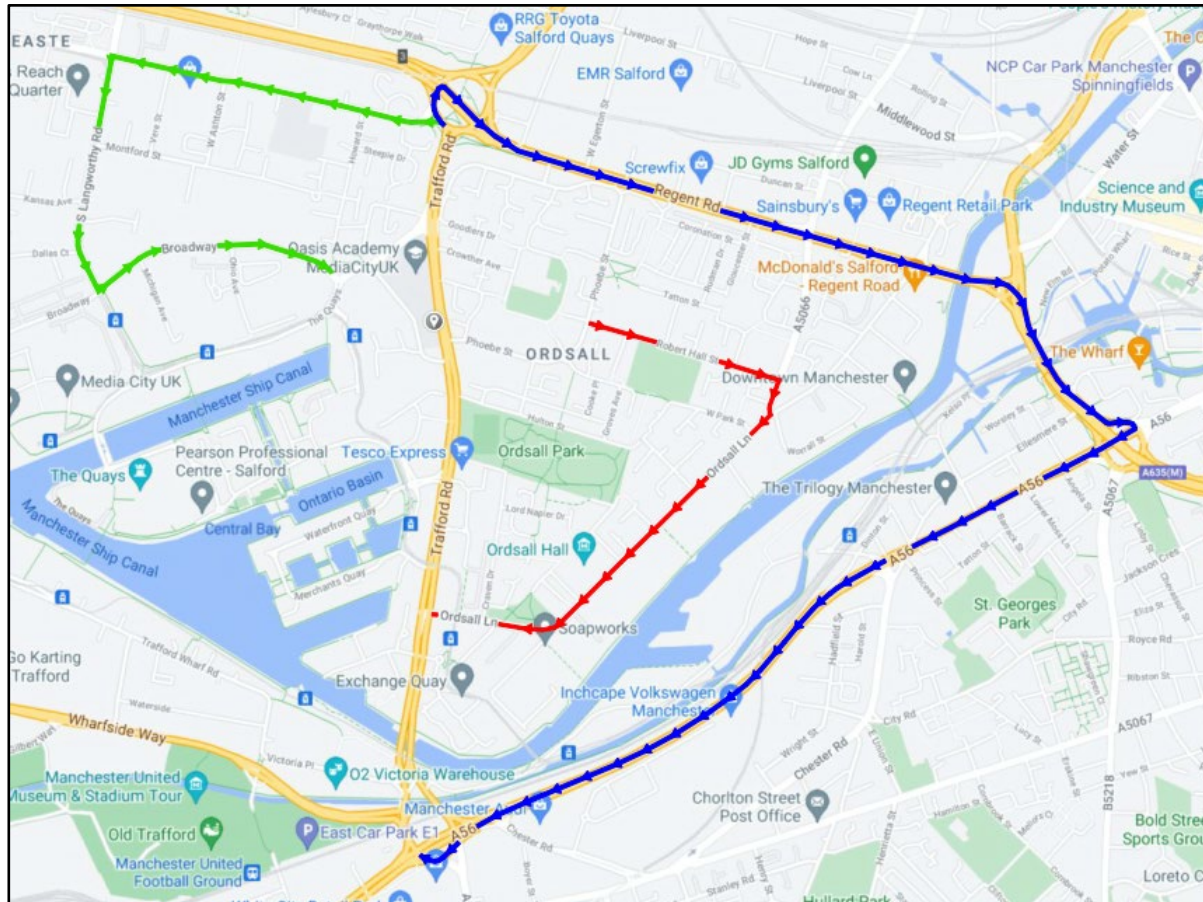

## Southbound diversions for traffic heading towards Trafford

- The southern side of Trafford Road will be closed.
- Traffic leaving the M602 travelling towards White City, Merchants Quay, Clippers Quay or Exchange Quay will need to follow the blue diversion route which starts at the M602 Roundabout heading onto Regent Road.
- Traffic leaving M602 travelling towards Media City and The Quays will need to follow the green diversion route which starts at the M602 Roundabout heading onto Eccles New Road.
- The red route is for local traffic access only. Trafford Road will be closed at the junction with Phoebe Street.

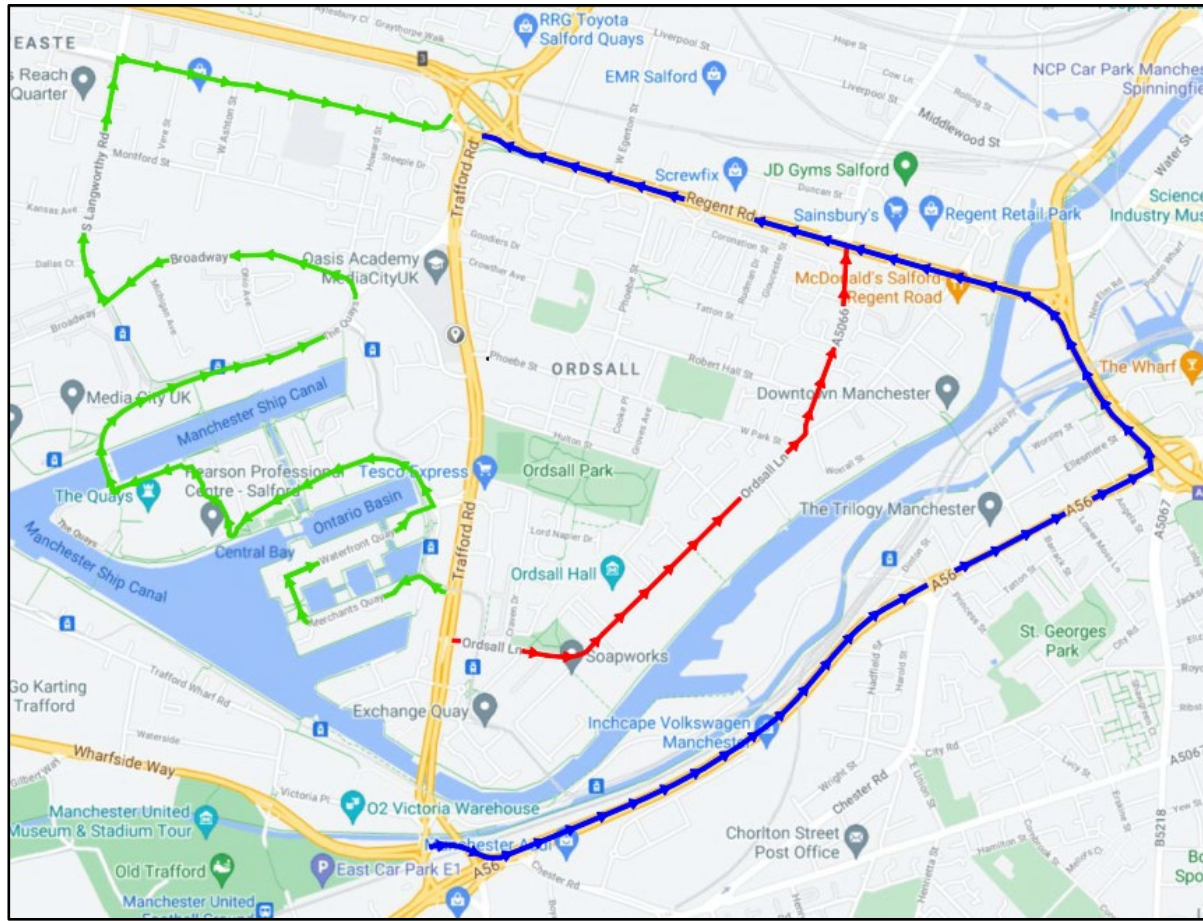
- Diversion Route 1 – for all traffic leaving the M602 heading towards White City Roundabout
- Diversion Route 2 – for all traffic leaving the M602 heading towards The Quays or Media City
- Diversion Route 3 – for local traffic access only



## Northbound diversions for traffic heading towards M602 Roundabout

- The northern side of Trafford Road will be closed.
- Traffic travelling north when leaving White City will need to follow the blue diversion route which starts at White City Roundabout. Traffic leaving Merchants Quay, Clippers Quay or Exchange Quay will be sent down the southern side of Trafford Road to join the main diversion at White City Roundabout.
- Traffic travelling north when leaving Media City or The Quays will need to follow the green diversion route which starts at Merchants Quay.
- The local diversion shown in red is only for people who need to access the housing estate or businesses via Ordsall Lane. It should not be used by HGVs or non-local traffic.

- Diversion Route 1 - for all traffic leaving White City roundabout heading north towards the M602
