Year 5 Lesson Plan 7

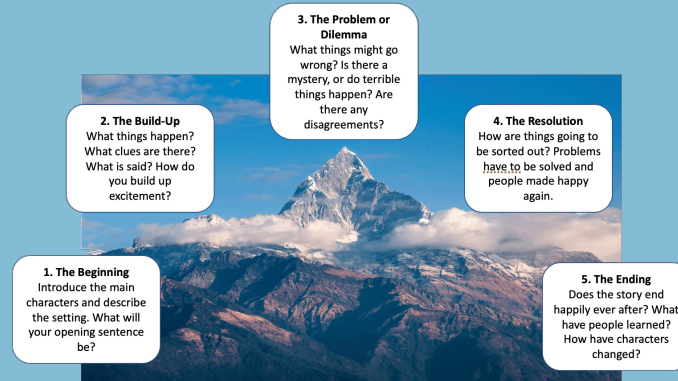
The end of the story means that you are coming down the story mountain.

- James saw his dog and walked up to her.


Use punctuation, or better words to improve these sentences
