Can you improve these sentences?


- · Yasmeen walked home from the forest

You are now going to write the ending to your piece of creative writing.

All the loose ends need to be tied together.

It needs to flow from the beginning, through

to the middle and then to the end.



Resolution

The ending: Is your writing going to have a good ending? A bad ending? Or a cliffhanger?

Are you going to tell anyone about your adventure? How is your problem solved? How are you feeling? What have you learnt from this?

Writing the end First, check what you have so far. Do you need to make any amendments? Are you ready to begin?
